



BASIC FACTS & FIGURES:

NONPROFIT NURSING HOMES¹

- There are 4,226 nonprofit nursing homes in the U.S., representing about 27% of the 15,884 nursing homes in the U.S. About 6% are government-owned and the remaining 68% are for-profit. These percentages have remained virtually unchanged over the past fifteen years.
- All three ownership groups have experienced declines in numbers since 2005, but the rate of decrease among non-profit and government facilities was greater than among for-profit facilities. For-profit nursing homes decreased by less than 1%, while both government and nonprofit facilities decreased by approximately 7%.
- There are approximately 3,277,924 nursing home residents in the U.S. Of these, 885,207 (27%) are in nonprofit nursing homes while 2,238,041 (68%) resided in for-profit nursing homes. The remaining 154,676 (5%) residents are in government-owned nursing homes.
- The states with the largest percentage of nonprofit nursing homes are Alaska, Delaware, District of Columbia, Iowa, Kansas, Minnesota, Montana, New York, North Dakota, Pennsylvania, and South Dakota.
